SwimRVA is building social bridges through aquatics that cross physical, racial, and economic barriers. Making aquatics accessible is central to why we are here. One of the ways we do this is by offering significant financial aid to families with gross annual incomes below 300% of the federal poverty guidelines. Depending on qualifying income level, SwimRVA covers between 40-80% of program and facility fees to ensure aquatics are financially accessible.
