Updated Statement Regarding Incident at SwimRVA-North

(June 22, 2026) - SwimRVA-North will remain closed through at least this week out of respect for the family and their grieving process. At this time, we do not yet have a clear picture of what the coming weeks will look like. We are thoughtfully evaluating next steps and will continue to communicate updates to our families and the community as decisions are made.

(June 19, 2026) - Our hearts remain with the family of King Overton and everyone affected by this devastating loss. We are grateful to see our community come together to support one another and honor his memory. We continue to extend our deepest condolences to the family.

In support of King's family and loved ones as they gather to honor and remember him, SwimRVA-North will remain closed through at least next week to allow for this important time of remembrance and reflection.

Due to the ongoing review of this incident, we are limited in the details we can share at this time. We are fully cooperating with the appropriate authorities and will provide updates as we're able.

Statement Regarding Incident at SwimRVA-North

(June 15, 2026) - It is with profound sadness that we report that at approximately 2:30 p.m. on Monday, June 15, a participant in our summer camp was unresponsive after being removed from the pool.

Pool staff immediately began CPR and continued lifesaving efforts until paramedics and County Fire Department personnel arrived and assumed care. The child was transported to the hospital, where he passed away.

Our hearts are with the child's family and loved ones during this loss. We extend our deepest condolences and are keeping them and all those affected by this tragedy in our thoughts.

We are cooperating fully with the appropriate authorities as they review the circumstances surrounding this incident.
